### **Important Details**

- **Format:** The questionnaire is **bilingual** (English and Hindi).
- **Scope:** It seeks opinions on pay structures, retirement benefits, and working conditions for Central Government employees, Union Territory employees, Judicial Officers, and pensioners.
- **Anonymity:** Responses are analyzed on an aggregate, non-attributable basis to maintain privacy.
